Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This church building is a one story, wood frame structure in the Queen Anne style. The building has a basic rectangular shape with a gable roof and cross gables. A square bell tower rises on the west (front) elevation and has an open belfry with a square, cone roof. The exterior of the church displays several textures: imbricated shingling, horizontal shiplap siding, and a band of vertical milled boards at the eaves.
